On the basis of demonstrated proficiency, a student may be granted a reduction in (i.e., waive) required courses. Proficiency must be established to the satisfaction of the course instructor and Directors. A student may waive no more than six semester hours of eligible courses based on graduate courses completed elsewhere prior to admission to the Program. Practicum, required clinical courses, dissertation, and internship may not be waived.
